



INSTITUTIONAL COVENANT « CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE » « FACULTAD DE TEOLOGÍA ASAMBLEAS DE DIOS »

PREAMBLE

CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON and the THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN, are theological institutions that are founded on the Holy Scriptures and dedicated to the capacitation of leaders for the development of the church and the fulfilment of its mission. For this reason, we maintain our doors open to all those that have been called of the Lord to dedicate themselves to Christian leadership and to offer programs of preparation in various areas of the ecclesiastical-pastoral fields of service.

These study programs concentrate on the analysis and comprehension of the Scriptures and of theology as well as a socio-anthropological understanding of man in his contemporary cultural setting; for it is our indispensable charge to reach our fellow man with the message of the Gospel. It is with this understanding that we constantly seek to relate theoretical knowledge and its application to all areas of ministerial functions. Thus, our students learn by way of investigation and analysis as well as the appliance of their knowledge in their field of work.

So then, with the purpose of instituting a covenant of institutional and academic collaboration that favours reciprocity in the formation of Biblical-theological-pastoral studies, « CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON », and the « THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN », officially establish, on this date, the following PACT of Institutional RECOGNITION AND ACADEMIC COLLABORATION.

ACADEMIC ASPECT

- 1). The joint venture of these two institutions is governed by the here-in mentioned COVENANT.
- 2). The « CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON », and the « THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN », mutually recognize one another as Institutions of Superior Theological Education.
- 3). The « CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON », and the « THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN », recognize, accredit and validate all Biblical-theological-pastoral



studies of the corresponding academic ministerial programs to the Bachelor Degree graduation level that are successfully taken in the respective centres of study in accordance to this present covenant.

4). The «CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON», and the «THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN», will accept as students from the graduate level programs giving the recognized accreditation for the courses studied in these respective seminaries and conveniently integrating them into the appropriate academic level deserving of the successful completion of said studies in the theological seminary that receives them.

5). The «CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON», and the «THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY A.D.», will accept as students from the post graduate level program (to work towards a Master's degree) to all those students that have earned a Bachelor's degree in theology from their respective seminaries and that, at the same time fulfil the academic requirements of the host country.

6). By way of this covenant, we agree to celebrate together as one, when the circumstances of special courses so require, seminars, special trips, symposiums, etcetera, each institution bringing with them those professors that are deemed required for said functions.

7). The students of both institutions can participate in courses and seminars given by either one of these two institutions and receive the corresponding credits.

9). Given the relationship that is being established by way of this pact, all students and professors of both institutions can participate in any activity given by these participating centres, enjoying the very same functioning status and position during such events in both establishments as they do in their own institution.

RELATIONS

10). The official relationship between the « CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON », and the «THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN», will be conducted by way of the rector of the « CHRIST THE REDEEMER COLLEGE OF LONDON», Dr. Daniel Akhazemea, and by the rector of the «THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD OF SPAIN», Dr. Jesús Caramés Tenreiro.

11). The present covenant will have the duration of ten years, beginning from the date that this pact is officially signed by all parties involved. Said pact can be renewed for a period determined by the signing parties and modified when agreed upon by mutual consultation.



12). This present covenant will be null and void the moment that one of either party so requires by way of a validated writing by a sanctioned authority of the institution motivating the annulment.




